**Program Content:** Uncompensated care (UC) from worksheet S-10 of the Medicare cost report is now used to determine over \$8B in national payments for UC disproportionate share hospital (DSH) funding.

Medicare auditors have recently started detailed audits of this information which will likely effect UC DSH payments in federal year 2020. DSH hospitals must ensure UC cost is reported in compliance with cost reporting instructions that are complex and vague in some areas. Importantly, the process of recognizing UC involves multiple departments and functions - from the financial assistance policy, to claims processing to summarizing and reporting on the cost report. This presentation focuses on working with a multi-disciplined hospital team in building your hospital's policies and procedures to ensure compliant reporting of uncompensated care.
